### 1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, class rules for the Club 420, Laser, and Optimist classes, the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

1.2. The Organizing Authority is Columbia Yacht Club and Columbia Sailing School.

Laser Standard

6.2. The racing area will be east of the Monroe Harbor entrance.

### 7. SUPPORT BOATS

7.1. All competitors are required to have a Support Boat.



7.2. All Support Boats are required to act as safety boats for any competitor in need of assistance.

**8. PRIZES**

Prizes will be given first through third in each class.

**9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**10. PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RIGHTS**

As a condition to participating in the regatta, competitors and their parents or legal guardians grant the Organizing Authority, and its agents, employees, sponsors, and assigns, the irrevocable right and permission to use basic competitor information, photographs and video footage taken of themselves and their competing boat, without notification, for use or distribution in any media whatsoever for editorial or advertising purposes, or to be used in press information. Competitors agree to release, defend, and hold harmless Organizing Authority, all five constituent yacht clubs, and their agents, employees, sponsors, officers, members, committees, and assigns, from and against any claims, damages or liability arising from or related to the use of the photographs and video footage.
