2	If emergency medical attention is required, call for help. A. To request ambulance or EMT Coach or Race Committee calls 911. Make sure to give them clear directions as to where they should park to be close to the dock where the injured sailor will arrive. St Joseph Coast Guard also monitors 911 broadcasts. B. For on-the-water rescue Coach or Race Committee contacts the US Coast Guard.
